Footnotes

PEARL RING broke sharply, angled inwards dictating the pace under light rating racing into the turn, maintained a narrow advantage on her own courage into upper stretch, was roused clear racing through the lane and just held SCARLET TEE under pressure. The latter secured a forward placing three deep between foes, tracked the leaders outside a rival racing into the bend, angled out three wide while moving to challenge nearing midstretch, continued to close the gap on the winner to the end and just missed. LE BEE was urged to a forward placing between foes from the outset, tracked just off the pacesetter racing into the turn, advanced to press that foe nearing upper stretch but weakened late when proving no match. TOP PAIR, caught in tight quarters not long after the start, was bumped, then forced to check off MONEDA DE ORO, settled into stride along the inside, gathered momentum leaving the turn, split foes just off the inside in upper stretch and produced her best stride late to gain a share while bidding inside the leaders. KATIE MURPHY tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight five deep early, made steady progress on the bend, angled out four wide in upper stretch and continued willingly. LOVE THAT KITTEN shifted outwards at the start bumping COZEY DEEDS, was collected to track just off the leader along the rail, shifted off the inside on the bend while maintaining striking distance but lacked the needed final bid. LIPSTICK LADY, reserved off foes in the opening half, passed between tiring rivals in the stretch. ITALIAN REVOLUTION, reserved in hand while angling nearer the inside in the opening stages, split foes racing through the turn,

angled out five deep entering upper stretch but lacked the needed rally. COZEY DEEDS, bumped from both sides in the opening stages, tracked the pace behind the second flight along the rail racing into the turn but couldn't produce the needed closing response. MONEDA DE ORO shifted inwards while racing in tight quarters just after the start, exchanged some contact with TOP PAIR, was righted to track the pace between foes, angled to the inside nearing the lane but steadily faded entering upper stretch. SHAQUITA settled outside foes in the opening stages, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and dropped out.
