**Footnotes**

BABA BOOYAH, urged to gain a position just off the pacesetter racing to the backstretch, came under pressure on the far turn to advance then continued into the stretch with a steady late response to prevail in time under firm handling. STARDUST RAJ moved to the fore along the rail racing to the backstretch, dictated the pace in hand to the second bend, was roused to maintain her advantage near midstretch and just failed to contain the winner. SARAROYAL tracked off the second flight along the inside racing to the far turn, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve her placing. JEFFELL tracked the leaders inside a rival in second flight to the far turn, shifted out nearing midstretch crossing into the path of ARMS RACE but had no final bid. ARMS RACE tracked the leaders outside a rival in second flight in the opening half, continued between foes on the far turn to upper stretch, was carried out a bit nearing the furlong marker by JEFFELL while shifting into the path of NEVERRGUWITRICHIE and steadily faded. STARIANA was settled outside foes in the opening stages and never seriously menaced. NEVERRGUWITRICHIE tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half, made some brief progress three deep on the far turn, but quickly dropped nearing midstretch when she was shuffled in traffic. I SEE MAMBO trailed throughout. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN BUT NO ACTION WAS TAKEN.
