### Footnotes

MAVERICKING, reserved saving ground in the last flight racing to the backstretch, came around a tiring foe steadily gaining position on the far turn, switched back to the rail to bid inside the pacesetter in upper stretch and responded to strong handling to edge clear late. BOWMAN'S SECRET, on terms with a rival attending that foe's pace racing to the backstretch, moved to dictate terms after a half while remaining a bit off the inside, resisted grudgingly when challenged nearing upper stretch and held gamely to the end for place honors while failing to contain the winner. DAD ARE WE HERE tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance racing four wide to the backstretch, made steady progress to challenge four wide racing through the far turn, drew on terms with the pacesetter nearing upper stretch but was outfinished. SPY HUNTER, held up off the second flight between foes racing to the backstretch, split foes three deep racing through the far turn while being urged to advance, shifted out six wide in upper stretch and produced a belated response to close the gap. LUMBERYARD JACK was settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, made steady progress outside foes to loom five deep midway through the far turn but failed to sustain his momentum in the last quarter. KNIGHT AFTER NIGHT broke inwards making some contact with ROI LE ROY at the start, was guided to the rail racing into the first turn while gaining a position in the second flight, shifted out nearing the second bend to press the issue between foes racing through the far turn but came up empty in upper stretch. ROI LE ROY, bumped at the start, was settled between foes racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. NUCKSER, urged to dispute the pace inside a rival racing into the backstretch, gave way entering the far turn when proving no match. MY EX tracked off the first flight from out of striking distance in the opening stages, continued between foes into the second bend but retreated from contention early.
