CHORAGUS, reserved between foes in the last flight early, made steady progress between foes on the bend advancing on the leaders, shifted three wide in upper stretch, then came through tight quarters nearing the furlong marker while exchanging some contact with RIPE TOMATO but wrested command from that foe to prove best under firm handling. RIPE TOMATO tracked off the second flight three deep early under some reserve, made a steady advance to striking position shifting four wide nearing upper stretch, exchanged some contact with the winner while moving to strike the front near midstretch but couldn't match terms with that foe late. KATHLEEN L tracked just off the pacesetter on the rail racing as part of the second flight in the opening quarter, was shuffled out of tight quarters entering upper stretch, switched off the inside and continued willingly to edge a rival for a share. AT THE FINISH tracked just off the pacesetter outside a rival in the opening stages, moved to challenge for command between foes entering upper stretch and was outkicked in the last furlong. HELLO AGAIN tracked the leaders unhurried along the inside in the opening stages, angled out five wide entering upper stretch but lacked any further response. I JUANA WIN sped clear of her rivals while angling over, pulling a bit against a rating hold, set the pace on a clear margin into the turn and emptied out abruptly in upper stretch.
