Footnotes

DADDY FORTY NINE, reserved out of striking distance in the opening stages racing a bit off the inside, split foes midway through the backstretch commencing a steady advance, continued three deep between foes into upper stretch, altered course leaving the sixteenth marker to challenge inside MOMENTARILY and just edged that foe on the wire under firm pressure. The latter tracked off the second flight outside a rival while under some reserve early, advanced on the leaders with a four wide move on the far turn to gain command nearing upper stretch, held sway on a narrow margin past midstretch and just failed to contain the winner. THAT I AM, reserved off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, steadily drew into striking distance on the far turn while shifting to the outside, angled five wide in upper stretch to challenge outside his entrymate and continued with a steady bid to gain a share. ALABAMA GOLD, forwardly placed outside the pacesetter, moved to press the issue three wide between foes racing into the far turn, disputed the issue inside a rival into upper stretch and was outfinished in the last furlong. FRANK'S TIME raced in midpack near the inside in the opening half, angled out entering upper stretch and continued evenly between foes to late stages. ROADSTER settled along the inside in the opening half, shifted out to split foes in upper stretch and made an effort to improve his position. MARKSMILK IS WHITE settled off the second flight outside, made some brief progress while angling out five wide entering upper stretch and lacked the needed final bid. BOSCO RULES hopped in the air at the start, was urged to secure a contending position inside a rival in the second flight, switched out nearing the far turn to press the pacesetter between foes on the second bend but came up empty nearing upper stretch. WHATITSALLABOUT settled outside foes in the opening stages and never gained contention. INCREDIBLEE sped to the

fore along the inside, set the pace under pressure racing into the far turn and emptied out abruptly after six furlongs. LORD AND T. bobbed at the start, raced wide throughout and never seriously menaced.
