### Footnotes

SINGER'S LEGACY, bumped at the start, was held up saving ground racing just behind the second flight in the opening stages, made a steady advance to striking position racing inside foes into upper stretch, came through close quarters to bid for command inside foes and prevailed in time under firm encouragement. BIG BEAR HUG was held up off the second flight racing off the inside in the opening stages, shifted out after a half to advance five wide entering the far turn, moved to command on the second bend, held sway into upper stretch, drifted out under some left handed pressure late, couldn't fend off the winner but continued well enough to save place honors. SWAINS NEWS went up from the break to dispute the pace along the rail, dueled between foes racing through the stretch and continued with interest to hold for a share. MOLANDER, urged to a forward placing, was taken up out of tight quarters entering the first turn to track just off the first flight, continued under firm rating into the second bend while awaiting an opening after six furlongs, angled out five wide in upper stretch and continued with some interest while no match for the leaders. BUD SYMONDS settled along the inside from out of striking

distance early, saved ground to upper stretch and made an effort to improve position a bit off the inside late. PEDESTAL, caught five wide racing to the backstretch tracking just off the second flight, continued in that path racing into the far turn and couldn't produce the needed closing response. INVISIBLE STAR angled inwards to prompt the pace between foes racing into the first turn, dueled between foes racing into the far turn and gave way in upper stretch. FOXTROT OSCAR was urged to gain terms with the first flight while angling in sharply racing into the first turn, forced the pace three wide racing into the far turn, continued to dispute the issue between foes into upper stretch and gave way. WILENTZ, held up out of tight quarters at the start, never gained contention. ACATATLAST broke outwards, bumped SINGER'S LEGACY, was settled along the inside racing to the backstretch and never menaced thereafter. ALONE AT LAST, between foes in second flight, shifted out on the first turn while making a sharp, four wide advance to contention, secured a position just off the first flight after a half, was rated in that position racing into the second bend and steadily faded from contention. BONDSTEEL was settled between foes early, angled out six wide on the backstretch but soon dropped out of contention.
