SHELLBARK, prominent four wide in the opening stages, eased off the pace tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance racing to the turn, made a steady advance to challenge four deep in upper stretch and continued with a steady late response to prevail in time under firm right handed pressure. ONE MORE TAP tracked the leaders between foes in second flight, steadied a bit nearing the turn when losing his path to R. CAMPFIRE, split foes near the inside racing through the stretch and continued with a steady effort to prevail for place honors. R. CAMPFIRE, forwardly placed three deep between foes in the opening stages, shifted inwards nearing the turn dropping off the first flight, came through along the rail in upper stretch to challenge inside the leaders and was just outkicked. THE NEXT SAINT, urged to a forward placing from between foes racing to the turn, pressed the pacesetter into upper stretch and weakened late. CLYDE BANK urged to the lead along the inside, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way. TILLO broke awkwardly, recovered to track off the second flight racing to the bend but offered no rally. TIP OF THE LAKE tracked the leaders inside foes in second flight racing into the turn but couldn't produce a closing bid. RAP ON FELIX settled well off the pace, shifted out racing through the turn and never seriously menaced. JET E LEE BOYYYY was never a factor. OF COURSE CARTER dropped out early.
