BIZZEE MIZZEE, in touch with the leaders racing into the first turn, was eased off the pace to track the leaders along the inside into the second bend, came through along the rail to challenge entering upper stretch and produced a steady late response to edge ROMAN INVADER under firm encouragement. The latter, close up between foes racing into the first turn, was eased off the leaders racing through the backstretch, made steady progress three deep on the second bend to challenge nearing upper stretch, forced the issue outside the winner past midstretch and was just outfinished. AMERICA'S BLOSSOM tracked well off the first flight in the opening half, angled to the rail racing through the far turn and continued willingly inside the top pair to close the gap while earning a share. HEAVENLY LASS, reserved along the inside racing to the backstretch, angled out five wide racing through upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. CATALINA WAY, urged to contention four deep racing into the first turn, pressed the pacesetter into the far turn and gave way. THE BEST OPTION settled outside foes racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. JITTERBUG BLUES hopped at the start, was settled between foes racing well out of striking distance, made some brief progress racing into upper stretch but lacked a needed final response, then was pulled up abruptly after crossing the wire and was vanned off the course. SEANS SILVERDANCER, urged to the lead between foes racing into the backstretch, set the pace under pressure racing into the far turn and gave way in upper stretch.
