Footnotes

DEVIL KISSES tracked the pace from out of striking distance behind the second flight while remaining well off the inside racing to the bend, came under pressure racing through the turn to advance, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and produced a steady late response to wrest command in time under firm right handed encouragement. FAMILY SIX tracked off the second flight under some reserve while angling inwards a bit, angled out five wide entering upper stretch and found his best stride late to close the gap. MOB BOSS, urged along three deep chasing the leaders into the turn, moved to challenge in that path entering upper stretch, struck the front nearing the furlong marker but was outkicked by the top pair. TOUGH ESCAPE angled inside chasing the leaders as part of the second flight racing into the turn, shifted out nearing midstretch and finished evenly late. REBUTTABLE, urged to a forward placing attending a rival's pace, pressed that foe racing into upper stretch but gave way leaving the furlong marker. PRAIRIE MASTER shifted out in early stages to race in the five path, tracked the leaders between foes off the second flight racing into the turn and lacked a closing response. JOHORE, reserved off the pace while being guided nearer to the inside early, never gained contention. ACT TOO was hustled to the lead along the inside, set the pace for a half and gave way in upper stretch. BOTTOM LES PIT was never a factor. SUNDAY NEWS dropped out early.
