LOVE STAR set the pace from off the rail then was no match for the winner in the drive but saved the place. SPOOKED settled in in good position off the rail but lacked a winning rally when asked. SMART WILDCAT raced close up three wide but weakened a bit in the drive. QUIET KINGDOM raced near the middle of the field and lacked a rally. MISSING TREASURE raced between horses and gave way early. MEHO ROUGE raced close up inside, steadied on the backstretch and gave way. GO WEST MADAM stumbled at the start and was pulled up.
