Footnotes

DUNDALK DANCER, forwardly placed along the rail racing into the first turn, switched outside the pacesetter entering the backstretch while steadily moving to terms with that foe, took over midway through the far turn, forged clear under pressure racing into upper stretch and was taken in hand in late stages once the issue was decided. MUTUALLY EXCLUSIVE, reserved off the second flight off the inside in the opening half, continued with a steady bid three deep on the far turn to gain second racing into the stretch but never menaced the winner. POTATOE PUDDING broke awkwardly while losing position to the field, settled into stride to the backstretch, angled out five wide racing into upper stretch and made a belated effort to improve position. SAIGEE GIRL, bumped at the break, was collected to track off the second flight inside foes racing to the far turn but had no closing response. CAUSEMOMMASAIDSO tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in the second flight, was urged to make a brief bid on the far turn and emptied out racing into upper stretch. RAJA BREEZE, urged to the lead along the inside racing into the backstretch, gave way once headed after six furlongs. FRENCH CHICK broke inwards bumping SAIGEE GIRL at the start and never gained contention.
