FOREST RUN secured terms with several foes racing three deep just off the pacesetter while under light rating in the opening stages, steadily moved to terms with the leader after a half, forced the issue past midstretch and wrested command in time under firm right handed encouragement. KNIGHTFIESTER was hustled to the lead along the rail, set the pace into the bend, responded when challenged nearing upper stretch to maintain a narrow advantage but proved no match for the winner late. HART OF A COWBOY, rated just out of striking distance along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch and continued willingly nearest the rail to close the gap on the top pair late. CLOCKER BOB tracked the pacesetter within striking distance while between foes in the opening stages but lacked the needed closing response. TWELLO tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening quarter, shifted out five wide nearing midstretch and made an effort to improve his position. TORO GRANDE, reserved outside foes tracking behind the second flight early, advanced to contention racing four wide on the turn but had no final response. U STEP ASIDE was settled outside foes in early stages and never seriously menaced. SUNSHINE EXPRESS, urged along to maintain striking distance four deep in the opening stages, continued three deep between foes on the bend and soon retreated from contention.
