LITTLE KICK broke sharply to secure the lead, dictated the pace outside a rival racing into the bend, edged clear nearing upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm handling. TOTEЕ tracked just off the pacesetter three deep in the second flight in the opening stages, bid in that path nearing upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the winner but prevailed for place honors. CHARLIE MURRAY, firmly rated between foes in the second flight awaiting an opening racing into the bend, split rivals nearing upper stretch to bid inside the leader, couldn't gain even terms with that foe and was outfinished for second. COPUS, pulling hard racing along the rail while moving to position just off the leaders in the opening stages, was steadied in traffic nearing the bend losing position, saved ground to upper stretch and made an effort to regain some position inside foes in late stages. BET SEATTLE tracked off the second flight while shifting inwards a bit in early stages, moved to challenge three deep between foes racing through the turn but flattened out nearing midstretch. LUV BANDIT was settled between foes well off the second flight early and improved his position three deep between rivals racing through the stretch. LATENT RUSH was hustled up the inside to briefly contest the pace racing into the bend but gave way after a half. HE'S SMASHED tracked the pace four deep off the second flight racing into the turn and steadily retreated. CHATFIELDS CHAP broke outwards, was settled outside foes in early stages and never gained contention. DE GREEN LIGHT broke slowly and trailed throughout.
