Footnotes

NAME DROPPER, prominent between foes in the opening stages, was eased off the leaders to stalk those foes along the inside racing into the backstretch, shifted out three wide on the far turn commencing a steady advance, moved to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch and drew away in the last furlong under firm encouragement. JACK'S TIGER, urged between foes racing into the first turn prompting a rival's pace racing into the backstretch, disputed the lead on a narrow advantage outside that foe racing into the far turn, pressed between foes into upper stretch, couldn't match the winner late but held grudgingly for place honors. GILDED QUEST was urged to the lead along the inside racing into the first turn, dueled for command along the rail on the far turn to upper stretch, couldn't match the winner late and was outfinished for second. WILD COMMAND, bobbled, then was bumped from both sides at the start, settled into stride racing four wide to the backstretch, split foes racing through the far turn and continued with a steady effort to improve position. ROCK ON RICHIE broke outwards bumping WILD COMMAND, was settled collecting his stride racing to the backstretch, then passed outside some tiring rivals racing into the stretch. BIG SMOOTH settled between foes off the second flight racing to the backstretch and never gained contention. JACOB'S LIGHTHOUSE settled along the along inside in the opening stages, shifted outside foes nearing the far turn but offered no closing bid. WILD PARTY broke inwards bumping WILD COMMAND, was urged between foes to gain a position in the second flight, shifted to the inside tracking the leaders into the second bend and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. RAJABLOU broke slowly, was rushed four wide into the first turn to gain terms with the first flight, continued outside a rival tracking just off the leaders in the second quarter and was spent after a half. LIGHTNING FIR, held up along the rail avoiding some close quarters racing into the first turn, soon dropped out of contention.
