**Footnotes**

A NICE SLEWISH BOY tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance under light rating outside a rival in the opening stages, responded readily when urged to challenge three deep between foes racing through the far turn, then edged clear through the stretch under firm encouragement. HERE COMES MARIO, pulling a bit along the inside tracking off the second flight in the opening stages, switched outside foes on the far turn gathering momentum, swung five wide nearing upper stretch while being prompted to advance, continued in that path into the stretch but proved only second best. RISING ICON shifted out early tracking off the second flight racing to the backstretch, was urged to challenge four wide racing into the far turn in tandem with the eventual winner but couldn't produce the needed final response while continuing well enough to prevail for a share. GUNS DONOVAN broke inwards bumping JINGLE JANGLE, was righted quickly, then hustled to the lead racing into the first turn, set the pace along the inside into the second bend and gave way leaving midstretch. CONTEMPORARY ART, forwardly placed tracking just off the pacesetter in the opening half, lodged a brief bid between foes racing through the far turn but came up empty in the final quarter. GAELIC BREEZE, held up along the inside in the second flight tracking just off the leaders to the far turn, shifted out three deep nearing upper stretch while being prompted to advance but had no closing bid. JINGLE JANGLE, bumped soundly, then shuffled back at the start, never gained contention. HIPPODROME trailed throughout. A NICE SLEWISH BOY WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM FIRST TO UNPLACED FOR A MEDICATION VIOLATION.
