Footnotes

WAYNE'S KITTEN took up a position off the second flight near the inside in the opening stages, shifted out nearing the bend commencing a steady advance, split foes midway through the bend while drawing into striking distance, shifted out three wide in upper stretch and continued with a steady late response to wrest command in time under firm encouragement. MY TEE TIME joined the pace outside a rival from the outset disputing the lead, dueled for command racing into the turn, edged forward racing into upper stretch, resisted the winner to the end but came up second best. SAINT PATTY ANN settled into stride along the inside in the opening quarter, switched outside foes racing through the turn, angled seven wide in upper stretch and found her best stride late to prevail for a share while no menace to the top pair. STEPHANIE'S CAILIN tracked the pace between foes off the second flight and continued evenly into the lane. LITTLE WHITE STAR settled five wide in the last flight early, was fanned six wide into the stretch and gained some position in an even effort. AUTUMN SPLENDOR broke slowly, was guided to the inside racing through the backstretch, shifted outside a tiring foe racing through the turn to race between foes just off the inside but offered no closing bid. MYKUKUBIRD was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival from the break, dueled for

command racing into the turn and emptied out in upper stretch when proving no match. BOSS GIRL tracked just off the leaders while caught four wide racing to the turn, continued in that path on the bend while making a brief bid but steadily faded racing into upper stretch. DANI NIKKI was never a factor. TAKE MANHATTAN tracked off the second flight racing three deep between foes into the turn but never seriously menaced. PRANKSTERBDANCING tracked just off the first flight along the rail in the opening stages but steadily retreated racing through the turn.
