FOR FILLIES, TWO YEARS OLD. (FOALED IN 2011.) Eligibles must be registered with the Illinois Department of Agriculture as Illinois Conceived and Foaled or Illinois Foaled Thoroughbreds. By subscription of \$25 each horse made on or before July 1, 2012. (fee to accompany nomination.) To remain eligible the following payments must be made: \$100 each on or before March 1, 2013. \$250 each on or before August 1, 2013. If the \$25 nomination fee is not made in a timely manner, a late nomination fee of \$500 must accompany the March 1, 2013 payment. Nominees to pay \$750 each to pass the entry box, \$750 each additional to start. \$75,000 to be added from the Illinois Department of Agriculture and Hawthorne Race Course. All monies to be divided 60 percent first; 20 percent to second; 11 percent to third; 6 percent to fourth; 3 percent to fifth. Weight; 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 at a mile or over allowed, 2 lbs.; at any distance, 4 lbs.; a race other than maiden claiming or starter, 6 lbs.; maidens, 8 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to breeder and owner of the winner. LAKOTADREAMCATCHER, reserved in last near the inside racing to the backstretch, switched off the inside approaching upper stretch gathering momentum, swung out four wide entering the lane and continued with a solid late kick to wear down SASY MS ELIZABETH in time under strong handling. The latter moved to terms with a rival on the pace attending that foe's tempo under light rating in the opening half, edged forward to dictate terms on a narrow margin between foes nearing upper stretch, held brief command approaching midstretch but was collared in the final strides. TANGUERAY MISS tracked just off the first flight under rating while switching a bit off the inside, was urged to advance on the leaders while switching out three wide entering the far turn, pressed the issue racing into upper stretch but flattened out leaving the furlong marker. PISTOLS DRAWN was urged to the lead while angling inside, dueled for command inside foes into the far turn and gave way racing into upper stretch. PRAIRIE VISTA reserved off the second flight while shifting off the inside, continued evenly into the stretch while failing to make an impression. BYLIA, urged to a forward placing three wide ion the opening stages, prompted the pace in that path racing to the far turn and soon gave way. LADY SILVETTE settled along the rail racing into the first turn and dropped out early.
