ST. LOUIS CITY secured terms with a rival on the pace soon after the break, attended that foe's tempo under light rating racing into the bend, took over nearing the furlong marker and drew clear late under firm encouragement. GOODY GOODY tracked the leaders out of striking distance off the inside in early stages, angled to the inside racing through the turn, split foes near the inside midstretch and narrowly prevailed for place honors. APACHEE TEE, forwardly placed three deep stalking the leaders, moved to challenge in that path racing into upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the winner and was outfinished for second. ROSE WITCH tracked just off the first flight four deep in the opening stages, made a brief bid in that path racing through the turn but steadily faded nearing midstretch. FLO'S STRAWBERRY, urged to secure the lead along the inside, set the pace on a narrow margin to upper stretch and gave way in late stages. SHARP EXCHANGE bobbled at the start, settled between foes and never gained striking distance. SLIGO BREEZE tracked just off the leaders along the inside racing to the turn and steadily faded nearing upper stretch.
