Footnotes

ITZACOLDCASE gained a position three deep in second flight tracking the leaders under some reserve, continued in that position through the turn, shifted four wide nearing midstretch, then drew even with BENT MISSILE in the final sixteenth to just edge that foe on the wire under firm handling. The latter joined the pace outside a rival soon after the start, prompted that foe racing into the bend, dueled past midstretch to gain a narrow advantage late and was just edged on the wire. HEART THIEF settled well off the field in the opening half, angled out eight wide nearing midstretch and was going well late to just miss. CITYRAP tracked off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages, angled out five wide racing through upper stretch while being urged to advance and continued to make mild progress between foes to the end. CATINATREE, urged to secure the lead a bit off the inside in the opening stages, dueled for command past midstretch but weakened late. KATHLEEN L, reserved off the second flight in the four path racing to the turn, angled out seven wide nearing midstretch while gradually gaining striking distance but was outkicked. KEL'S DREAMER, urged to gain a position between foes in the second flight early, tracked the leaders under some reserve racing into the bend, was urged to challenge between foes in close quarters three deep nearing midstretch but proved empty in the last furlong. WILD ORATION stumbled at the start, was held up out of close quarters just after the break, angled to the inside to track off the second flight, saved ground on the bend but steadily faded from contention.
