FAST EDDIE CHARLES vied for the lead off the rail and held sway in the drive. STEP RIGHT IN raced close up inside and gained the place while unable to reach the winner. A TO Z lacked speed angled out and gained belatedly. POWER SOLDIER raced close up four wide and lacked a rally. BAILER TWINE lacked speed and made a bid in the stretch but flattened out. BULL'O THE WOODS raced between horses and lacked a rally. MR. COLD COMFORT was never a factor. STOP THE RACE raced three wide and gave way. SWEET WATER RIM contested the pace from the inside and tired.
