ALL THE FACTS raced in the middle of the pack, was in tight into the second turn and checked hard then made a mild rally late. POWERMINDED raced in the middle of the pack, raced four wide in the turn and ran evenly. AVENUE TROLLEY showed no speed and passed tiring rivals while eight wide. BRIGHT STORM showed no speed and was no factor. DRUM LINE was in tight into the first turn and saved ground but made no rally. LONESOME SKIER chased the pace, raced four wide into the turn and faltered. HOPETOWN HERO chased for a half and stopped.
