Footnotes

EILEEN EVELYN was held up off the second flight in the opening half, pulled her way to striking distance while shifting out three deep on the far turn, wrested command nearing upper stretch and drove clear. PRINCIPALIA, bumped at the start, was reserved well off the field to the second bend, swung out four wide leaving the second bend while gaining contention and proved best of the others. AFLEET ABACO settled off the second flight outside a rival in the opening stages, angled in entering the far turn while making some progress, shifted off the inside entering upper stretch and continued well enough to earn a share. SLIGO ROSE tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in second flight in the opening half, was roused to advance midway through the far turn but couldn't produce a closing bid. JULIE BUGS, urged clear near the inside racing to the backstretch, set the pace into the far turn and emptied out. JESSIES HONOR broke inwards bumping PRINCIPALIA, was settled off the second flight along the inside racing to the backstretch but never seriously menaced. DEVOUT DIVA was a brief factor inside a rival in the second flight but was through after a half.
