Footnotes

SILK OF SARI moved to the fore soon after the break, angled inside setting the pace on a clear margin in the opening quarter, resisted when challenged midway through the bend to regain a narrow advantage nearing midstretch and edged away late under brisk handling. CAMP FAIRFAX R N, forwardly placed three deep in the opening stages, moved to press the issue in that path racing into upper stretch but proved no match for the winner late. A SHOT AWAY broke sharply, stalked just off the pacesetter while shifting nearer to the inside, pressed the issue between foes racing through the turn to upper stretch but weakened leaving the furlong marker. PRINCES EVEN tracked the leaders from just out of striking distance near the inside while unhurried in the opening stages, angled four wide racing through upper stretch and continued evenly between foes. ROSE PRINCESS settled into stride along the inside, shifted out entering the turn while being prompted to advance, angled five wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a mild bid. SHARP TRIP tracked just off the leaders along the inside racing into the turn but offered no closing response. LET IT RAIN was settled outside a rival in early stages and soon trailed.
