Footnotes

LEMON CUSTARD was rated along the inside tracking the leaders as part of the second flight from just out of striking distance racing to the backstretch, pulled his way to contention along the inside racing into the far turn, continued with a steady advance inside foes entering upper stretch, then came through when presented an opening to wrest command in time under firm left handed encouragement. GUADALCANAL stalked just off the first flight three deep under rating racing to the backstretch, moved to challenge in that path on the far turn, pressed the issue into the stretch to strike the front but drifted out late while just failing to contain the winner. PRIME SPEED moved to secure a forward placing while shifting outside a rival racing into the first turn, gained a narrow advantage outside that rival after a half, disputed the lead between foes on the far turn to upper stretch, then drifted a bit in late stages while failing to match the top pair. MILES AND MILES bobbled at the start while being brushed by I'LL SHOW THEM, was settled between foes racing to the backstretch, angled out nearing upper stretch while being urged to advance, shifted six wide midstretch while being bumped by ALL IN SLEW but continued with interest to close the gap. SEGURO settled into stride well out of striking distance while shifting nearer to the inside racing to the backstretch, saved ground on the far turn, switched out in upper stretch to split foes three wide and made an effort to improve position. ALL IN SLEW tracked the leaders

outside a rival in second flight racing to the backstretch, angled out five wide nearing upper stretch while being urged to advance, drifted out making contact with MILES AND MILES leaving the furlong marker and had no final response. I'LL SHOW THEM broke inwards bumping MILES AND MILES, was reserved four deep racing to the backstretch as part of the last flight, made steady progress in that path racing into the far turn to loom outside the leaders in upper stretch but flattened out in the last furlong. FAITHOPE, reserved near the inside early, never gained contention. PART'N PARCEL was hustled to the lead from the break while angling sharply to the inside, dueled for command inside foes racing into the far turn and gave way abruptly entering upper stretch.
