TIZ PLAYTIME was reserved tracking the first flight while dropping out of striking distance in the opening half, commenced a steady advance nearing the far turn, pressed a rival into upper stretch then edged forward to a narrow advantage under firm encouragement in the closing stages. COUNTIN' ON U DOC joined the pace outside a rival from the break, pressed the issue for a half, edged away to a clear advantage between call on the far turn, resisted the winner's bid racing along the rail racing through the stretch but proved only second best. LADY SCATTERLEY, reserved in hand while being guided to the rail early, saved ground throughout to gain some position but had no closing bid. DIVINE DORIS settled between foes off the second flight in the opening stages, angled to the inside racing through the far turn to gain some position late but made no real impression. STAND UP RITA settled outside foes in the opening stages, continued four wide racing into the far turn but never seriously menaced. GO GO GRACIE bobbled at the start, recovered quickly while being hustled up the rail to contest the pace, dueled for command racing into the far turn and gave way. PARIS PASSION tracked the leaders inside a rival in the second flight for three furlongs but dropped out early.
