Footnotes

LUV BANDIT, a bit reluctant to load, was caught four wide racing into the first turn while being prompted to gain a contending position, continued with a steady advance in that path racing into the far turn to challenge for command, gained the advantage after six furlongs, maintained a narrow advantage past midstretch and withstood the late challenge of DREAMING BLUE to prevail under firm handling. The latter, brushed at the start by TABLE GAMES, was settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, gradually gathered momentum while angling out six wide in upper stretch and produced his best stride late to close the gap nearing the wire. YANKEE DEALER tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening stages, shifted out on the far turn to bid four wide racing into upper stretch but was outkicked by the top pair. TABLE GAMES broke outwards brushing a rival, was settled between foes near the inside from out of striking distance for a half, then split foes just off the inside racing into the stretch to improve position late. PLEASANT CLOSING tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight, shifted out nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed late bid. DUKE OF DEL REY tracked the leaders four deep off the second flight in the opening stages, was urged to make a brief bid while shifting out five deep racing into upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. PART'N PARCEL tracked the pace between foes in the second flight, lodged a brief bid three wide between foes entering the far turn but quickly came up empty. BOWMANS CASTLE, restless in the gate before the start, settled last along the rail in the opening stages and never gained contention.

COSTILLA RANGE was urged to the lead along the inside, dictated the pace to the far turn and emptied out once headed. PEDROLINO tracked the pace between foes off the second flight for a half and had no closing response. VOUCH FOR VICTORY was a brief factor prompting a rival's pace but emptied out early.
