Footnotes

ESLA MAMBO settled out of striking distance along the inside racing to the turn, angled off the inside entering upper stretch, shifted six wide leaving the furlong marker and produced a solid late response to wrest command in time under firm handling. MILWAUKEE WOLF, forwardly placed between foes in the opening quarter, was eased off the first flight racing to the turn, shifted five wide nearing midstretch to bid between foes and was just outkicked. JOHNS LION tracked off the first flight outside a rival in the opening quarter, angled nearer the inside on the turn, split foes near the inside nearing midstretch and continued willingly to the end to earn a share. JAUN DE LA PLAYA tracked the leaders along the inside in flight, shifted out three deep entering upper stretch while being urged to challenge and was just outfinished. SPREAD THE CHIPS settled into stride while shifting off the inside, was fanned six wide racing into the stretch, gained some position late but made no real impact. WATTS FERRY, urged to join the pace three wide between foes, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave out late. CART'S GLITTER, prominent four wide in the opening stages, pressed the pace outside a rival to upper stretch and gave way. LINE CAMP was hustled to the lead while angling to the inside, dueled for command into the turn and gave way after a half.
