REAL POWER, reserved in hand racing in last to the far turn, steadily gathered momentum near the inside on the second bend, shifted out five wide in upper stretch and produced a solid late response to wrest command in time under firm handling. YANKEE DEALER, reserved between foes in the second flight early, shifted three wide entering the backstretch while commencing a steady advance, struck the front between calls late but couldn't fend off the winner. TWELVE HUNDRED moved to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace in hand on a narrow margin along the rail to the second bend, was roused in upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum through the last furlong. PRINCE CHEVAL, forced inwards by BLING KING at the start, was reserved along the inside, saved ground to upper stretch and improved his position inside foes in late stages. SHELLYS WILD angled inwards early to track just off the leaders between foes racing to the backstretch, shifted out entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. LAKOTA WOLF, urged four wide into the first turn joining a rival on the pace, attended that foe's tempo to the second bend, drifted out nearing midstretch and gave way. BLING KING broke inwards impeding PRINCE CHEVAL, was collected to track off the first flight along the inside under some reserve racing to the far turn but came up empty nearing midstretch. HERE COMES MARIO tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, was caught four wide midway through the backstretch and steadily faded. STRONGEST LINK, caught in tight quarters at the start, was reserved along the inside early, shifted out entering the backstretch but couldn't gain contention.
