ITALIAN REVOLUTION prompted the pace, angled in for the stretch run and edged clear in the final furlong. HEY JERRY set a contested pace, forged clear on the turn, proved no match for the top one in the stretch but stayed on to secure the place spot. KITTIE'S PRIDE outpaced early, was urged on the turn, moved four wide into the stretch and lodged a mild bid. G STREET BAND passed tiring rivals. EASTERN PRECIPICE raced forwardly along the inside and lacked the needed kick. PINEAPPLE PANCAKES stumbled at the start, chased the pace while four wide and had no rally. TOMATO LADY raced in striking position while three wide and faltered.
