### Footnotes

SURELY IRISH angled inwards gaining position just off the first flight in the opening stages, tracked those foes to the far turn, commenced a steady bid racing into upper stretch, drew on terms with CATALINA WAY in late stages and prevailed under brisk handling. The latter angled inwards joining a rival on the pace racing into the backstretch, shook clear entering the far turn, held sway on a clear margin past midstretch but couldn't contain the winner. NOKOMIS settled along the rail in the opening half, shifted out entering the far turn while being urged to advance and made some mild progress between foes to late stages while earning a share. YOU'RE BEINGPLAYED tracked the leaders unhurried from just out of striking distance in the opening quarter, shifted out on the backstretch, made brief progress to gain striking distance entering the far turn, angled out nearing upper stretch and soon flattened out. EAST COASTER tracked the pace unhurried between foes in the last flight racing to the backstretch, shifted out nearing upper stretch and improved her position between foes racing through the lane. SHINY STAR was urged to the lead along the inside, disputed the pace racing to the far turn and gave way nearing upper stretch. STRONG WILLED LADY settled outside foes in the opening half, was caught four wide racing into the far turn and steadily faded. LUCKY TIP tracked just off the first flight near the inside in the opening half but steadily retreated nearing upper stretch.
