Footnotes

MARKREE BREEZE, held up just off the first flight while outside foes in the opening stages, made a steady advance to challenge while being fanned four wide nearing upper stretch, took over nearing the furlong marker and drew away under firm handling. FLEET ENCOUNTER broke a step slowly, shifted to the inside, saved ground on the bend, switched out five wide entering upper stretch and made steady late progress to prevail for place honors. ROYAL SEVEN, held up just off the pacesetter along the inside racing to the turn, shifted out to split foes nearing upper stretch challenging for command but lacked the needed final bid. CHAPA RITA broke inwards bumping TYDRO, was righted, then urged to secure the lead along the inside, set the pace to upper stretch and gave way in late stages. TOAST WITH HONEY secured terms with a rival on the pace after the opening furlong, attended the pace between foes racing into the bend but came up empty after a half. ABBY'S SLEW tracked off the first flight from just out of striking position racing to the turn but couldn't produce a closing bid. EXPENSIVE DATE broke slowly and never gained contention. TYDRO, bumped at the start, retreated from contention early.
