PRETTY HEIRESS secured a forward placing along the inside soon after the start, shifted outside the pacesetter stalking that foe under some reserve after the opening quarter, moved to wrest command from that foe entering upper stretch, gained a clear advantage midstretch and just lasted under steady pressure. J'S HONOR gained a position just off the leaders racing three deep to the turn under rating, moved to challenge in that path racing into upper stretch and was getting to the winner late. PASSPOST TO PARIS settled between foes from out of striking distance racing to the turn, angled out five wide entering upper stretch and made steady progress late to close the gap while being outfinished for second. VARIABLE, reserved outside foes in the second flight early, angled in entering the turn, split foes entering upper stretch while being urged to advance but lacked the needed final kick. GET THE KITTY was hustled to the lead from the break, angled to the rail setting the pace, dueled for command on the turn into upper stretch and gave way. ZOOMIE ZOOMIE settled into stride along the inside racing to the turn and never gained contention. SURFIN WAVE was settled between foes in early stages and offered no rally. GREY LIGHT dropped out of contention early.
