STORMY BALLAD raced forwardly along the inside and stayed on. JIMMY'S IMAGE reserved early, lodged a bid on the turn and flattened out. OUTERBANKS chased along the inside and had no rally. ROCHE RESERVE passed tired ones. T. V. ALPHIN failed to menace. HERE COMES HENRY saved ground and proved no factor. CUBSWIN stumbled at the start, sprinted clear, was brushed aside on the turn and faded.
