LOVERBIL, in touch with the leaders three deep in the opening stages, stalked those foes outside a rival racing into the turn, was urged to advance three deep nearing upper stretch to challenge for command, gained a commanding advantage leaving midstretch while shifting to the inside and extended the margin to the end under firm left handed encouragement. CHONGO was urged to dispute the pace inside foes from the outset, dueled for command through the turn, proved no match for the winner racing into upper stretch but continued with interest to prove best of the others. PROPER EMPIRE, held up just off the first flight along the inside racing into the turn, shifted outside a tiring foe racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed final bid while continuing well enough to earn a share. DELUX DEELITE bobbed slightly at the start, was urged to dispute the pace outside a rival racing into the turn, shifted inwards while losing contact with the top pair after a half and soon gave way. BAND OF SILENCE, off a step slowly, was urged to contend four deep in the opening stages, shifted in racing into the bend racing as part of the second flight but had no closing response. TOTEE tracked the pace outside a rival in the second flight racing into the bend and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. TIZ SENSATIONAL tracked off the second flight five wide in the opening quarter, continued widest into the bend and never gained contention. NOBEL BIRD broke awkwardly, then was steadied while being righted after the break and trailed throughout.
