### Footnotes

JUSTA AVERAGE JOE was urged to force the pace outside a rival soon after the break, continued in an extended skirmish outside that foe racing into the stretch and narrowly prevailed late under firm encouragement. SCHOENE FRANZEL was urged to dispute the pace inside a rival from the break, shifted off the rail while continuing to dispute the issue through the stretch and was just outfinished. SENATOR DAVE, urged along four wide in second flight in the opening stages, moved to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. ENERGETIC SREVA tracked just off the leaders three deep between foes in the second flight early, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and continued evenly to late stages. LOOK WEST tracked just off the second flight outside a rival in the opening stages, angled in entering the turn while losing some position to the leaders and had no closing bid. SUMMER SERVANT settled off the second flight along the inside early and soon dropped out of contention.
