Footnotes

JUMP TO START was urged to secure the lead along the inside racing to the first turn, dictated the pace on a clear margin into the second bend, shifted off the rail racing into upper stretch and just maintained a narrow advantage to the end under steady handling. SWEEPY BLUFF was settled out of striking distance off the inside racing to the backstretch, split foes advancing to contention on the far turn, angled out four wide nearing midstretch and continued with a steady effort to close the gap while prevailing for second. DAKOTA MILKSHAKE tracked just off the pacesetter under light rating leading the second flight in the opening stages, was urged to challenge the leader on the far turn into upper stretch, gradually drew on terms with the leader in late stages but was outkicked by the top pair. ONE FOR BISCUIT, reserved between foes from out of striking distance in the opening half, shifted in to save ground racing through the far turn and continued willingly inside foes to late stages. IKAROS, reserved in last in the opening half, swung outside foes racing through the far turn, angled five wide nearing midstretch and continued with a mild bid. BEWARE THE TIGER, urged to secure a forward placing three deep between foes in the opening stages, steadily retreated in that path racing through the far turn. PLEASANTLYSURPRISE, caught four deep in second flight chasing the pacesetter into the backstretch, emptied out racing through the far turn. CLOUD CASTLE angled to the inside early tracking well off the second flight and dropped out of contention entering the far turn.
