RENO STAR broke sharply to gain a clear advantage in the opening sixteenth, shifted to the inside to dictate the pace on a narrow margin on her own courage racing into the bend, maintained the advantage racing just off the rail under pressure to late stages and was taken in hand once the issue was decided approaching the wire. DUBAI MAGPIE was urged to secure a forward placing stalking just off the pacesetter, was urged to challenge while shifting out three deep racing into upper stretch and continued with a steady effort to close the gap late while always only second best. SILVER DIRECTION, bumped, then forced out at the start, was settled just out of striking distance along the inside racing into the bend, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch and continued with a mild bid while earning a share. REBA'S FANCY came through close quarters at the start, was urged to a contending position along the inside stalking just off the pacesetter, moved to challenge for command along the rail nearing upper stretch but flattened out in late stages. JELLY BUTTER broke outwards bumping SILVER DIRECTION, was settled along the inside in the opening quarter, shifted out five wide racing into the stretch but never seriously menaced. MIDNIGHT BRUISER was never a factor.
