MAUDE S, reserved in hand off the inside racing in last to the backstretch, steadily advanced to contention racing four wide through the far turn, continued in that path racing into the stretch while continuing with a solid late response, then took over and drew clear late under firm encouragement. OUR LADY IN RED broke sharply, was rated outside foes in the second flight racing three deep to the backstretch, commenced a steady advance in that path to challenge for command when given her cue on the far turn, gained a clear advantage racing into upper stretch but proved no match when confronted by the winner in the final stages. SWEET LEMON CHELLO moved to the fore soon after the start to open a clear advantage, dictated the pace just off the rail into the second bend, briefly resisted when challenged racing into upper stretch but gave way in late stages. DUNDALK DUST tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages, was urged to advance between foes entering the far turn, shifted out three wide racing into upper stretch but lacked the needed late response. LOVE THIS KITTEN led the second flight on a narrow margin between foes tracking the pacesetter in the opening half, lodged a brief bid between foes racing into the far turn but flattened out quickly nearing upper stretch. TRAC N JAM tracked the pacesetter inside foes in the second flight for a half and steadily retreated entering the far turn.
