Footnotes

BIG BRUIN gained terms with the first flight between foes attending the pace racing into the first turn, continued with a steady bid to gain the advantage racing into the far turn, then held sway racing a bit off the rail while maintaining a clear advantage to the end under firm handling. BOBBY SANDS settled outside foes tracking off the first flight three deep in the opening stages, was urged to advance leaving the far turn while shifting out four wide racing into upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner but continued with interest to prevail for place honors. MILES AND MILES was rated between foes off the first flight in the opening half, split foes racing into the far turn while being prompted to advance, shifted to the inside nearing upper stretch to challenge inside the pacesetter but lacked the needed final kick. JUSTA AVERAGE JOE, forwardly placed three deep racing into the first turn, dropped off the first flight to track the leaders outside a rival for a half, shifted out nearing the far turn to lodge a three wide bid, continued between foes in that path to upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. ASK EDDY was urged to the lead along the inside racing into the first turn dictating the pace on a narrow margin, couldn't match the winner after a half and emptied out racing into the far turn. BLUEGRASS JET tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, shifted outside a tiring foe racing into the far turn and quickly retreated from contention.
