Footnotes

KITTY CITY tracked the leaders unhurried along the rail from just out of striking distance in the opening stages, made steady progress in tandem with a rival on the turn, shifted out three deep in upper stretch to wrest command and made the balance of the pace under pressure. OPTIMISTIC SREVA settled between foes in the opening stages, made steady progress racing just outside the eventual winner on the turn, angled four wide racing through the stretch but proved only second best. LAST CORONA, reserved outside foes in the opening stages, angled inwards a bit on the turn, shifted out five wide entering upper stretch and continued to improve position. RAVIN MANIAC was urged to the lead, dueled for command along the inside racing into the bend, then gave way after his rider lost his whip leaving the sixteenth marker. B N GRACED N GLORY prompted the pace outside a rival from the outset, pressed the issue to upper stretch and gave way. SPECTACULOUS was a brief factor outside the leaders in the opening quarter but was through after three furlongs.
