LAKEAWAY, a step slow into stride, settled outside foes in the opening half, shifted in on the backstretch, split foes near the inside leaving the backstretch advancing to contention, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch while producing a solid late response, wrested command and drew away under pressure. SASSY BUCK settled along the inside off the second flight in early stages, made steady progress to gain contention inside foes on the far turn, swung out four wide in upper stretch and proved best of the others. SHERRY'S TIGER dictated the pace along the inside into the backstretch, edged clear on the far turn, briefly resisted when challenged nearing midstretch but yielded to the top pair late. PRETTY IN MINK tracked off the second flight outside foes, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch, made an effort to improve position but made no impression on the leaders. UMMA UMMA tracked off the second flight in the opening half, shifted out nearing the far turn while making a brief, three wide bid between foes but lacked the needed final response. I'VE HEARD RUMORS settled near the inside, saved ground to upper stretch, shifted out a bit racing through the lane and improved her position. SURELY JACKSON joined the pace outside a rival racing to the backstretch, couldn't match the leader after six furlongs and gave way nearing upper stretch. AFLEET ASHLEY settled between foes in the opening half, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch but proved no factor. LANDERS led the second flight near the inside racing into the backstretch, came up empty after six furlongs and steadily retreated racing through the far turn. MS MANIPULATOR tracked off the second flight three deep in the opening half and steadily faded racing through the far turn. WILDWOOD GOLD tracked the pace between

foes in the second flight and dropped out nearing upper stretch. GOLDEN PATCH, caught five wide racing into the first turn, soon dropped out.
