MY KENTUCKY ROSE, never far back, stalked the pacesetter along the rail under rating racing to the backstretch, steadily moved to even terms with that foe entering the far turn while continuing under some reserve, struck the front between calls in upper stretch, was roused to turn back a challenge from GIMME THE CROWN racing through the stretch while exchanging some light contact with that foe and narrowly prevailed on the wire under strong handling. The latter broke outwards bumping BABY WILDCAT, was reserved from just out of striking distance off the inside racing to the far turn, swung four wide on the second bend moving to challenge, shifted inwards while coming under pressure and gaining terms with the eventual winner, continued in an extended skirmish with that foe past midstretch and was just outfinished. CIRCULAR STREET, held up just off the first flight near the inside racing to the far turn, briefly awaited an opening, shifted out to split foes three wide entering upper stretch and gained a share while finishing evenly late. MAGIC CHAPEL tracked just off the pacesetter three deep under rating in the opening half, moved to challenge between foes in that path racing through the far turn but lacked the needed final kick. BABY WILDCAT, bumped at the start, settled in last racing to the far turn and never gained striking position. TREE HUGGER moved to the fore between foes racing into the first turn, dictated the pace in hand on a narrow margin racing to the far turn but emptied out abruptly in upper stretch.
