Footnotes

HOLY BULLHIVE vied for the lead three deep between foes in the opening quarter, continued to contest the issue between foes just off the inside racing through the turn, gained the advantage in upper stretch and edged away late, drifting out in the closing stages despite firm right handed encouragement. MOONSHINE STILL joined the pace four deep between foes from the break, pressed the issue three deep racing into the turn to gain a narrow advantage after a half but couldn't match the winner's kick in the last quarter while continuing with interest to earn place honors. WILDWOOD HEIR, in touch with the first flight racing widest in the opening stages, dropped off the leaders to track those foes racing into the turn, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a mild bid in that path to late stages. RICH CITY DUDE settled off the leaders racing six wide in the opening quarter and continued evenly between foes to gain some position late. MACHO JOE was urged to dispute the pace between foes from the outset, dueled for command along the rail into the turn and gave way nearing midstretch. SCOTCHIRISH, in touch with the first flight nearest the rail in early stages, was eased off the first flight entering the turn, shifted out four wide nearing upper stretch while being urged to make a second challenge but lacked the needed final bid. MILITARY LEGEND, in close attendance to the pace five wide in the opening sixteenth, was eased off the pace after the opening furlong while shifting to the inside and steadily faded from contention.
