Footnotes

LITTLE MICHAEL was urged to gain a forward placing racing four wide in the opening quarter while moving to terms with a rival on the pace, attended that foe's tempo racing into the turn while shifting nearer to the inside, continued with a steady bid to wrest command in upper stretch and held sway to the end under pressure. DECOMMANDER tracked the pace three wide between foes in the second flight, shifted outside foes racing into upper stretch and continued well enough to prevail for place honors. SERRATED EDGE sped to the fore from the break, shifted to the inside racing into the bend dictating the pace on a narrow margin in the second quarter, dueled inside the winner to upper stretch but proved no match while drifting a bit late. MOST DISTINCT

tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight and continued evenly just off the inside racing through the stretch. STEEL HAMMER tracked the pace between foes in the second flight, shifted three wide racing into the stretch, shied avoiding a drifting foe leaving the furlong marker and weakened late. GRAN TORINE broke slowly losing position to the field, came around foes racing into the turn, angled to the rail in upper stretch and made some belated progress. SEASCAPE tracked the leader five deep in the second flight in the opening stages but retreated racing into the turn. FEAR NOR FAVOR was never a factor. TRUST MORE angled to the inside early tracking off the second flight but never menaced. MADMADSKILLZ showed little. GIMME A DOUBLE, a brief factor four wide in the second flight, was fanned wide racing into the stretch and steadily faded from contention. GOHOMEBAY dropped out early.
