PLEASE SIGN IN bobbled a bit at the start, quickly recovered to press the pace from the outside, took over on the second turn then was fully extended to hold off ROYAL BANDITA. ROYAL BANDITA was allowed to settle into stride near the middle of the field, angled out for the drive and gained steadily but just missed. COME SEPTEMBER raced close up in good position off the rail, moved closest to the winner on the final turn but could not get to that one and lost the place late. DYNA PERFORMER lacked speed inside then rallied belatedly but could not threaten. FACCIA BELLA saved ground, angled out for the drive, gained some ground and flattened out. LADY LOUWANE was always outrun. LU KEEL raced outside near the middle of the field and tired. MY DALLAS set a pressured paced from the inside and also tired.
