**Footnotes**

HUCKLEBERRY BOY broke inwards brushing PRIZE N SHINE, went to the fore along the inside, dictated the pace on a clear margin racing into the far turn, turned back a challenge from DENO'S BRIDIE nearing upper stretch and drew well clear in the final stages while being kept to the task. GAVILAN gained a tracking position outside foes in the second flight, made steady progress three deep on the far turn to gain striking position, couldn't gain terms with the winner racing into the stretch and just held a rival for place honors. LINCOLNSHIRE angled to the inside securing a position in the second flight racing to the backstretch, saved ground to upper stretch while making some progress but lacked the needed final response while being outfinished for the place. DENO'S BIRDIE broke outwards bumping PRIZE N SHINE, shifted out sharply while being urged to secure terms with the pacesetter racing into the backstretch, pressed the issue outside the winner on the far turn but gave way between foes leaving the furlong marker. PRIZE N SHINE broke inwards exchanging contact with DENO'S BIRDIE, was taken in hand to track the leaders off the second flight along the inside, saved ground to upper stretch and continued evenly. MAGIC MAN swerved out at the start, was held up along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out six wide racing into upper stretch but made no impression on the leaders. STRIVER hopped at the start, was settled outside foes in the opening stages, made a brief progress outside foes entering the far turn but quickly emptied out. SMARTY SPRINGS, reserved outside foes in the opening half, never gained contention. MADILLAC D'VILLE, forwardly placed outside foes in the opening furlong, raced a bit wide into the backstretch and quickly retreated after a half.
