MONASHEE ROSE was guided to the rail in the opening stages tracking the pacesetter unhurried while moving to terms with the second flight after the opening quarter, continued in that path to the second bend, shifted out a bit entering upper stretch to bid outside the pacesetter, then wrested command from that foe and edged forward late under firm left handed encouragement. VICARY ROSE moved clear of the field while angling to the inside entering the first turn, set the pace under rating into the second bend, was roused to turn back a challenge nearing upper stretch racing nearest the rail but couldn't contain the winner. PEOPLE SKILLS tracked just off and outside the pacesetter, made steady progress to close the gap on that foe entering the far turn but flattened out in upper stretch. NORTHERN SWALLOW bobbled at the start, was collected to track the leaders three deep as part of the second flight, continued in that path entering the far turn while lodging a brief bid but couldn't produce the needed final response. LUSESITA, held up as part of the second flight while shifting a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, switched out four deep nearing the far turn while making some brief progress but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. CALLALOO trailed throughout.
