Footnotes

MISTER BENTLEY broke sharply, was urged to the lead while angling to the inside, held sway on a clear margin into upper stretch and just held safe the challenge of CHIEF CHICAGO under pressure. The latter, held up just off the leader along the inside in the opening half, shifted out leaving the far turn to challenge, steadily closed the gap on the winner to the end and just missed. SMOKY STORM broke inwards bumping AFFAIR IN THE WOODS, was collected off that foe, saved ground to the backstretch settling well off the leaders, then continued nearest the rail to upper stretch while making some late progress to improve his placing. WILD JAZ, caught in tight quarters at the start, tracked the pace off the second flight near the inside, shifted out on the far

turn to split foes near the inside and improved his position between foes to the end. BLUE CANOE, reserved three deep in the opening half, shifted outside foes on the far turn, was fanned five wide racing into the stretch to gain some position but made no impression. JINGLE JANGLE, held up outside foes in the opening stages, was fanned six wide racing into the stretch and passed some tiring rivals. BIG POPPA D, caught five wide racing into the backstretch, dropped well off the field, then came around some tiring foes in late stages. ICHABODS REVENGE angled inwards gaining position in second flight, tracked the leaders between foes racing into the second bend and emptied out in upper stretch. RUN OR PASS tracked off the second flight outside foes into the backstretch, then faded steadily from contention on the far turn. FLYING ACT, forwardly placed three deep racing into the backstretch, chased the pacesetter in that path into the far turn and gave way nearing midstretch. PHEASANT LANE, in contention between foes in second flight early, was fanned five wide nearing the backstretch, made a brief advance in that path but was through after a half. AFFAIR INTHE WOODS, bumped at the start, recovered quickly, was pulling a bit racing near the inside in second flight entering the first turn, shifted out four deep carrying out PHEASANT LANE nearing the backstretch, made a brief four wide bid after a half, then steadily retreated racing into the stretch.
