Footnotes

AMAZING BUD was hustled to the lead along the inside in the opening stages, dueled for command into upper stretch, continued in an extended skirmish past midstretch while exchanging some contact with NATURDAY and narrowly prevailed on the wire under brisk left handed pressure. The latter was urged four deep between foes to gain striking distance after the opening furlong, shifted in nearing the turn to force the issue outside a rival, dueled for command in a prolonged drive past midstretch and was just outnodded on the wire. ANGEL FIRST CLASS, forwardly placed between foes tracking the pacesetter, shifted out three deep to challenge entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. CALL ME CAPTAIN tracked off the second flight outside rivals in the opening stages, angled inwards entering the turn but lacked a closing response. ESPRESSO settled well off the field in the opening stages and passed only tiring rivals. TOP NOTCH BUDDY was a brief factor inside foes in the second flight but dropped out of contention entering the turn. SHOTGUN LUKE tracked the pace under reserve between foes in second flight while going a bit erratically, shifted out racing into the turn while being urged to advance but gave way abruptly in upper stretch. STAR RATING was never a factor.
