Footnotes

YUKAN DO IT TOO came through close quarters in the opening stages to gain a position just off the pacesetter stalking that foe under light rating racing to the backstretch, moved to wrest command when prompted racing into upper stretch, steadily drew away under pressure and was taken in hand in late stages once the issue was decided. JUMP TO START, caught four wide racing into the first turn while being prompted to gain contention early, tracked just off the leaders three deep racing into the far turn, continued with a steady effort in that path to prevail for place honors but couldn't match terms with the winner in the final quarter. COURTLY, bumped soundly, then cut off at the start, settled into stride well off the field for six furlongs, swung out six wide racing into upper stretch and found his best stride late to gain a share. SUMMER'S EMPIRE tracked the pace inside foes in the second flight in the opening half, shifted out on the far turn. moved to challenge four wide racing into upper stretch but had no final kick. NEXT KITTEN, caught in tight quarters just after the start, moved to gain a position between foes in the second flight, tracked the leaders in that position into the far turn but had no closing response. KHUKURI moved to the fore while shifting to the inside, dictated the pace along the rail racing to the far turn and emptied out abruptly once headed by the winner in upper stretch. FRANK'S TIME settled off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground throughout while gaining some position racing into upper stretch but had no closing bid. TEXAS HEDGE, bumped by TWYLAS RED CAT, then steadied a bit avoiding close quarters just after the start, never gained contention. TWYLAS RED CAT veered in at the start bumping COURTLY and TEXAS HEDGE, was urged to position just off the second flight racing four wide to the backstretch, continued five wide on the far turn and steadily faded. IKAROS never seriously menaced while racing widest into

the stretch.
